

It was highlighted that there are activities that the network can start doing even before they get the registration, for example, collection of the network data, the training of leaders and management staff of SCUs, and standardization.

Women Entrepreneurial Development, a call to Action at the International Women's Day Celebration



ACCU successfully held the 2019 CU celebrations on International Women's Day Workshop on March 6-11 in Bangkok, Thailand attended by 23 Cooperative leaders and executives from Kenya, Nepal and Philippines.

The UN's theme for International Women's Day 2019, that took place on 8 March, was "Think equal, build smart, innovate for change". According to UN Women, the theme was focused on innovative ways in which we can advance gender equality and the empowerment of women, particularly in the areas of social protection systems, access to public services and sustainable infrastructure.

The workshop allowed attendees to reflect on the role of credit unions in politically and economically empowering women. It was followed by identifying policies, services and strategies needed to involve women at the board table and using entrepreneurial development as strategy to raise women above poverty. Attendees recognized the need for credit unions to assist women in developing their entrepreneurial skills to allow them engaged in viable and sustainable enterprises.
